If you are replacing a 2.x module with a 3.x module and must use exact match keying in the I/O configuration, take additional action depending on your version of RSLogix 5000 software.

If you use exact match keying and	Then you must
RSLogix 5000 software, version 13 or greater	 Delete the 2.x module from the I/O Configuration in the RSLogix 5000 project. Add a new 3.x revision module to the I/O configuration.
RSLogix 5000 software, version 12 or lower	Do one of the following: Change the module's configuration to Disable Keying.
	 Upgrade RSLogix 5000 software to version 13 or greater and complete the steps listed for RSLogix version 13 or greater.
